Job Purpose/Role Summary
<p>The Interviewer will be responsible for conducting oral history interviews with members of the Chinese community to collect their personal stories and memories and document their experiences and perspectives. The Interviewer will work closely with project stakeholders to select interviewees and develop interview questions that explore topics such as migration, journeys to Wales, cultural identity, and community engagement. The Interviewer will also be responsible for editing interview footage in partnership with the filmmaker/videographer and ensuring their accuracy, authenticity and quality.</p>



Key Responsibilities

- Work closely with project stakeholders to select potential interviewees who will deliver the most diverse range of stories.
- Develop interview questions and conduct oral history interviews with members of the Chinese community to document their experiences and perspectives.
- Ensure that interviewees are properly informed about the project and their rights as interviewees.
- Conduct interviews in a respectful, sensitive, language specific and culturally appropriate manner.
- Edit interviews in partnership with filmmaker/videographer and interpreter to ensure their authenticity, accuracy and quality.
- Manage interview data, including film footage, audio recordings, summaries and transcripts, in accordance with project protocols and standards.
- Attend project-related meetings and participate in project evaluation activities, including providing feedback on the interview process and outcomes.
